## HSNC Scholarship Opportunity 2021

In February 2016, the Board of Directors of the Hobe Sound Nature Center, Inc. established the Debbie Fritz-Quincy Scholarship for the Environment, to be awarded annually to a deserving student. - How has your volunteer service affected your daily life?
- Have you been involved in any other similar programs or volunteer opportunities with other organizations, businesses or agencies? Please describe all, including any paid positions or internships.
- What are your plans for college studies at this time?
- What would you like to do with a college degree following graduation?
